Book Sales in the Queset House

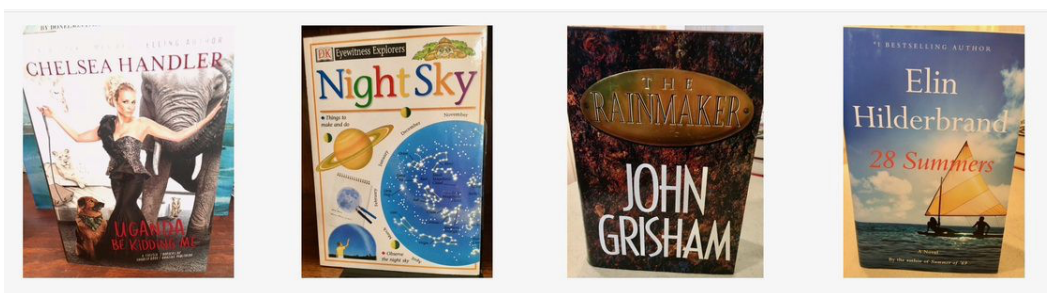

Books in poor condition will not be accepted. Please note our criteria:

- Only 25 books per donation
- No dust, mold, stained or torn pages, or notes in the margins. If you wouldn't buy it, please don't donate it!
- No textbooks, magazines, encyclopedias, dictionaries, or CDs
- Never leave books outside the building

If you want to donate more than 25 books in excellent condition, please contact the Friends at amesfreefriends@gmail.com to make an appointment. Many thanks for your understanding.
